This week there are pictures to colour, activity sheets to complete and play dough to make.

Dear parents, this week we have again used Roots on the Web resources for inspiration. Jesus' 'last speech' in John's Gospel talks of the relationship that exists within the Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The challenge for us is not only to begin to understand and enter into that relationship, but also to play our part in it by glorifying (lifting up) God.

Jesus talks to the Father about being glorified and prays for his followers.

Read the passage:



Jesus looked up to heaven and prayed: 'Father, the hour has come. Now is the time for me to be glorified. You have given me power over everyone. I will give eternal life to all those you have given to me. They will know you as the one true God and they will know me as Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

'I have brought glory to you in the way I have lived my life on earth. But now I have finished the work you gave me to do. And so, Father, the time is right

for you to glorify me in heaven.

'I have told the people that you sent me and that you are God. They believe in you and have been faithful to you. They know that the things I have taught them come from you, and that everything I have comes from you.

'I am not asking for the world's sake, but for the sake of those who belong to me. And all those who belong to me are yours. Now I am no longer in the world,

but they are still in the world. I am leaving them to come to you. So I ask you, Holy Father, to protect them in your name, so that they may be as one, just as you and I are one.'

Activities

So I can give glory to you

Make a shape with play dough which represents God the Father. If you haven't got any play dough you can make it.

You will need

8 tablespoons of plain flour

2 tablespoons of salt

60ml of warm water

food colouring (optional)

1 tablespoon vegetable oil

To make the play dough mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In a separate jug mix together the water, a few drops of food colouring (if wanted) and the oil. Pour the liquid from the jug into the flour and stir. You can then use your hands to squeeze the mixture together to form a ball then roll/knead it on a work surface until it feels ready to play with.
