Notes

1. The only churches at present in communion with the Church of England are other Anglican Churches and certain foreign Churches – including the Old Catholic Church in Switzerland.
2. Membership of the Electoral Roll is also open to members in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity where those members are also prepared to declare themselves to be members of the Church of England.
3. Every six years a new roll is prepared and those on the previous roll are informed so that they can re-apply.
