The Church Committee at their Meeting on Tuesday last took note of your telegram from Colombo and quite agree that you should pass a few weeks in England with your family. We have tried unsuccessfully to procure extension of Mr. Dames's leave over and above the reglementary three months limit - it appears that his locum tenens has been ill on one Sunday and a layman had to be licensed to take the Services and there were also other complications.
